CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Josef F. and Mathilde J. Wagner, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial (Trailer Park) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Tract 43, T.16S., R.56E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Tract 43 bears S. 25° 22' 00" W., a distance of 340 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Indian Springs, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.078 c.f.s., but not to exceed 4.377 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 15, 1975

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by a 150 foot deep drilled well, 8" casing, equipped with a 3 HP submersible pump. Water is pumped into a 525 gallon pressure tank, hence into a distribution system which serves a 36 unit trailer court, all within a portion of Tract 43, T.16S., R.56E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
