CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Willis A. Swan, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for manufacturing purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 18, T.19N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 bears N. 47° 35' W., a distance of 122.6 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Kennametal, Inc.
Post-office address Fallon, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.6016 c.f.s., but not to exceed 75,040 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 28, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in the well, thence conveyed some 10.6 miles via a distribution system to a 25,000 and 50,000 gallon storage tank at the place of use which is in Section 1, T.20N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., excluding the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 where it is used for manufacturing purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
