CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John H. Milton, III, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 26, T.35N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 26 bears S. 1° 29' W., a distance of 1229.8 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

18.23 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 26, T.35N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M.
19.58 acres in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 26, T.35N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M.
37.81 acres total

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 29871 which changes the point of diversion of Permit 28620 which changes the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 26839, hence the date of priority remains the same as Permit 26839.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
