CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER.

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WHEREAS, H. W. Settlemyer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada proof of appropriation of water from West Carson River and Branches through the Tillman and Falk Ditch for irrigation of the lands herein described, lying and being in Douglas County, Nevada, and for

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 13, Chapter 4, Statutes of Nevada, 1903, has determined the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows:

 General Priority Number on main stream 23; Priority Number on West Carson - 23.
 Amount of Appropriation, 72 acre feet per year; Amount of prior appropriations, 8056 acre feet per year; Date of Appropriation 1879 Amount of equal priority 72 acres.; Description of land to be irrigated, and for which this appropriation is determined.

72 acres W 1/2 N. E. 1/4 Sec. 5 T. 11 N. - R. 20 E.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to irrigation.....and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; ~~rights for irrigation not to exceed three acre feet per year for each acre of land for which appropriation is herein determined~~
