WHEREAS, W. H. James & Bro. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada proof of appropriation of water from Carson river through the Williams Slough Ditch for irrigation of the lands herein described, lying and being in Douglas County, Nevada, and for

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 13, Chapter 4, Statutes of Nevada, 1903, has determined the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows:

The right to water hereby determined is limited to irrigation and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; ~~rights for irrigation not to exceed three acre feet per year for each acre of land for which appropriation is herein determined~~
