## CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER.

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WHEREAS, E. Marshall has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada proof of appropriation of water from Muddy River through the Overton Canal Ditch for irrigation of the lands herein described, lying and being in Lincoln County, Nevada, and for

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 13, Chapter 4, Statutes of Nevada, 1903, has determined the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows:
