## CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER.

WHEREAS, Joseph P. Martin has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada proof of appropriation of water from A. Spring through the \_\_\_\_\_ Ditch for irrigation of the lands herein described, lying and being in Esmeralda County, Nevada; and for Domestic Mining Etc.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to irrigation \_\_\_\_\_ and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed three acre feet per year for each acre of land for which appropriation is herein determined.
