TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Engineer of the State of Nevada intends to dismiss the above-entitled adjudication proceeding without prejudice to the water rights or the water right holders unless good cause is shown by any interested party by written submission received in the office of the State Engineer within 60 days of the date of this notice why such proceedings should be continued.

WHEREAS, the records of the State Engineer show that this adjudication has proceeded through the issuance of an Order Granting Petition for Adjudication and the publication of a notice thereof as required by NRS § 533.110. There has been no action on this adjudication since 1989. A letter was mailed to all interested parties on March 9, 1998, by the office of the State Engineer indicating the intent to discontinue the adjudication if no interest was shown. There was no substantive response to this letter indicating a desire to proceed.

WHEREAS, the records of the State Engineer show conveyance of Proof 04225 and Permit 41881 into Hamilton Properties from the R. Ruth Foundation and Donnell J. Richards et. al., respectively. The two water rights are now in the name of one owner; therefore, there is no conflict in ownership of the subject waters.

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that the above entitled adjudication proceedings shall be vacated on July 20, 1998, unless good cause is shown why said proceedings should continue.
