
Dear Mr. & Mrs. Machacek:

In as much as we have permitted rights on the below mentioned creeks, and in as much as there is a need for regulation of these creeks, please consider this letter as formal notice to have these creeks adjudicated.

Preston Creek-

Located in Eureka County, Nevada and which our point of diversion is the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5, T. 20 N., R. 54 E.M.D.M. or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Sec. 5 bears North 72° 32' West 4499.54 ft.

Cottonwood Creek-

Located in Eureka County, Nevada and which our point of diversion is the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 6, T. 20 N., R. 54 E.M.D.M. or at a point from which the N. E. corner of said Sec. 6 bears North a distance of 645.0 feet.

Hildebrand Creek-


Located in Eureka County, Nevada and which our point of diversion is the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, T. 20 N., R. 54 E.M.D.M., or at a point which the SW corner of Sec. 18 T. 20 N., R. 54 E.M.D.M. bears South 54° 28' 14" West a distance of 11,307.05 ft.

Torres Creek-

Located in Eureka County, Nevada and which our point of diversion is the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec.17, T. 20 N., R. 54 E.M.D.M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 18, T. 20 N. R. 54 E.M.D.M., bears South 83° 16' West at a distance of 5588.26 ft.

Please initiate these proceedings as soon as possible so that the lawful regulation of these waters will be forthcoming.
