Dear Sir:

This office is ready to go ahead with the adjudication of water rights on Seigel Creek. We desire to proceed under section 36b of the water law, copy of which is inclosed herewith. Our reason for proceeding under this section is that we can expedite the adjudication proceedings and have the same completed before the next irrigation season. A copy of the waiver is inclosed herewith in case you desire to waive publication of the various notices, etc. For your information we will state that the various notices if they are fully complied with as required by law will take approximately six months' time. By complying with the provisions of section 36b of the water law, these notices are waived without in any way jeopardizing the rights of the people on the stream system. Your early attention to this matter will be greatly appreciated.
