THIS INDENTURE, made the 8th day of August, A.D. 1929, between M.B.MOORE and KATE K.MOORE, his wife, of the City of Oakland, County of Alameda, State of California, the parties of the first part, and OTTO T. WILLIAMS, of the City and County of Elko, State of Nevada, the party of the second part,

W I T N E S S E T H:

That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00 Dollars, lawful money of the United States to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever:

An undivided one-quarter interest in and to all of those certain pieces and parcels of land situate in the County of Eureka, State of Nevada, and described as follows, to-wit:

The East half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$), the East half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$), the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$), and the West half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 20; the East half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$), the East half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the East half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 29; the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the West half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 32, all in Township 31, North, Range 52 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, known as the "Home Ranch".

AND ALSO all water, water rights, dams, ditches and easements heretofore and now used in the irrigation of said lands and for stock and domestice purposes.

TOGETHER with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular, the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

This deed is made subject to that certain option to purchase of date, the 5th day of March, A.D., 1929, wherein and whereby the said B.F.Curler and M.B.Moore gave and granted unto J.P. Raine of Washoe County, Nevada, the exclusive right and option to purchase from the said B.F. Curler and M.B.Moore, the foregoing described property for the period of nine months from the 5th day of March, A.D. 1929.
