WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00), in lawful money of the United States of America, and other valuable consideration, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all of their right, title, interest, claim and estate, of, in, and to all those certain lots pieces, or parcels of land, situate, lying, and being in the County of Humboldt, State of Nevada, and bounded and particularly described as follows, to-wit:
