That the undersigned, FRANK C. MORTIMER, BUILDING AND LOAN COMMISSIONER OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, pursuant to the power vested in him by the Building and Loan Association Act of the State of California, and particularly Section 13.11 thereof, has, and does by these presents, assign, transfer, grant, convey and set over unto PACIFIC STATES SAVINGS AND LOAN COMPANY, a California corporation, all real and personal property of every kind and character, and wherever located, now constituting assets of Pacific States Savings and Loan Company and standing in the name of either said Pacific States Savings and Loan Company or Frank C. Mortimer, as Building and Loan Commissioner of the State of California, in possession of the property, business and assets of Pacific States Savings and Loan Company, including, without in any manner limiting the generality of the foregoing, all lands (whether improved or unimproved), hereditaments and appurtenances, all cash in hand or in banks, all choses in action, notes, mortgages, deeds of trust, street improvement bonds, and other evidences of indebtedness, all books, records, files and papers relating to said real and personal property, and all furniture, fixtures, equipment, merchandise and stock in trade used in connection with the operation of the property, business and assets of Pacific States Savings and Loan Company; it being the intention of the undersigned by these presents to fully and completely assign, transfer, grant, convey and set over unto said Pacific States Savings and Loan Company all of the aforementioned real and personal property, and every part thereof, to the end that said Pacific States Savings and Loan Company will be vested with title there- to in the same manner as if the undersigned and his predecessors in office had never been in possession of the property, business and assets of said Pacific States Savings and Loan Company.
