PITT, resident of the City of Lovelock, County of Pershing, State of Nevada, the party of the first part, and W. C. PITT COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Nevada, with principal place of business at Lovelock, in said County of Pershing, the party of the second part,

W I T N E S S E T H :

That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other valuable considerations to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL, CONVEY and CONFIRM unto the said party of the second part and to its successors and assigns forever, all those certain lots, pieces or parcels of land, situated, lying and being in Lovelock Valley, in the County of Pershing, State of Nevada, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

All of Section Nine (9), and all of Section Fifteen (15), in Township Twenty-seven (27) North, Range Thirty-one (31) East, M. D. B. & N.
