O R D E R

DECLARING PREFERRED USE FOR  
THREE LAKES VALLEY (SOUTHERN PART)  
GROUND WATER BASIN  
CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA

WHEREAS, a portion of Three Lakes Valley (southern part) groundwater basin was described and designated by Order No. 745, issued by the State Engineer on May 28, 1980, as a groundwater basin coming under the provisions of Chapter 534, NRS (Conservation and Distribution of Underground Water).

WHEREAS, the only permitted groundwater use in the designated portion of the basin is for penal institution.

WHEREAS, the State of Nevada has a need to expand its prison facilities and such expansion is in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE, the State Engineer, as of the date of this order, declares penal institutions to be a preferred use of the groundwater resource in the designated portion of Three Lakes Valley (Southern part) groundwater basin pursuant to NRS 534.120.
