The office of the State Engineer has determined through investigation that you are the owner of one cased well and one uncased well located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. The well sites are in the Truckee Meadows Ground Water Basin and further described as APN 49-440-12 at Washoe County. A search of the records of this office indicate there are no existing water rights or a well log for the subject wells.

Information available to the State Engineer indicates that no appropriation exists at either well, in violation of NRS 534.020(1), which provides that all underground water belongs to the public and is subject to appropriation under law. Furthermore, the present condition of the subject wells provide a conduit for possible waste contamination of potable underground waters, in violation of NRS 534.020(2).

The State Engineer finds the construction of both wells not in compliance with the Regulations for Drilling Water Wells as adopted under Chapter 534 of the Nevada Administrative Code and pursuant to the authority under NRS 534.060(4), the State Engineer finds both wells defective and must be immediately plugged and abandoned.

YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to the authority under NRS 534.070(4), to plug and abandon the well within sixty (60) days of the date of this order or the State Engineer may, without further notice, pursue appropriate action as provided in NRS 534.070(9).
