WHEREAS, in a conference call that occurred on October 8, 1991, between the State Engineer, counsel for the applicant, Department of Energy and intervenor, State of Nevada concerning the continuation of the hearing in the above entitled matter set for October 10 and 11, 1991 in Las Vegas, Nevada, it was agreed that neither party would have additional witnesses or evidence to present; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to enter briefs and additional exhibits; and

WHEREAS, it was agreed that such briefs and exhibits do not need to be entered in a formal hearing setting.

THEREFORE, the hearing in the above entitled matter will be closed by this Order with the provision that the record will be left open for one more exhibit provided by applicant and submitted by intervenor, such exhibit being pumpage records at the Nevada Test Site with applicant's objection to the relevancy so noted and another exhibit being this Order,

AND FURTHER, simultaneous briefs will be received fifteen (15) days after receipt of the transcript.

AND FURTHER, that five working days will be allowed after receipt of the simultaneous briefs for reply for each party.

There being nothing further except for the above set out exceptions the hearing is hereby closed.
