WHEREAS, the State Engineer has information that you are the owner of a lot described by Assessor's Parcel Number 18-249-03 in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30, T.18N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M., Silver Springs, Lyon County, Nevada.

WHEREAS, a field investigation on March 3, 1993 by staff of the Division of Water Resources found on said parcel an abandoned well described as having 8 inch casing covered with a rusty five gallon bucket.

WHEREAS, the State Engineer concludes that this well is a possible point of contamination and pollution to the groundwater resource.

WHEREAS, Chapter 534.020 of the Nevada Revised Statutes states "It is the intention of the legislature ... to prevent the waste of underground waters and pollution and contamination thereof ...".

WHEREAS, the State Engineer finds that no water right exists at the above described parcel as appropriated under Chapters 533 and 534 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

WHEREAS, the State Engineer has granted permits under the authority of Nevada Revised Statutes 533 and 534 to ERGS, Inc. for the purpose of serving water to the area which includes said parcel therefore no domestic use can be made from the well.

NOW THEREFORE YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED to plug and abandon this well within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order. The plugging and abandonment of this well must be in accordance with Chapter 534.420 of the Nevada Administrative Code.
