EXPANDING THE AREA OF CURTAILMENT OF WATER
APPROPRIATION OF GROUNDWATER IN THE OREANA GROUNDWATER BASIN,
PERSHING COUNTY, NEVADA.

On February 25, 1969, the State Engineer, by Order No. 369, designated the entire Oreana Groundwater Basin (4-73A), Pershing County, Nevada.

On February 25, 1969, the State Engineer, by Order No. 370, described an area in the Oreana Groundwater Basin in which no additional permits to appropriate groundwater for irrigation purposes would be granted. In addition, the State Engineer, by Order No. 370, declared that municipal use is a preferred use within the designated area. That area is described as:

T.29N., R.33E. - Sections 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, the E1/2 of Section 18, the SW1/4 and the E1/2 of Section 19, Sections 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36.

T.28N., R.33E. - Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8.

Following a public hearing to consider expanding the preferred use area, an Order is hereby made by the State Engineer and entered into the records of the Division of Water Resources expanding the area described in Order No. 370 to include:

T.29N., R.33E. - Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and that portion of the E1/2 of Sections 6 and 7 lying east of the Humboldt River.

T.30N., R.33E. - Sections 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, and that portion of the E1/2 of Sections 7, 18, 19, 30, and 31 lying east of the Humboldt River.

Therefore, for the above described area, municipal use is declared a preferred use and no permits to appropriate groundwater for irrigation purposes will be issued.

All other provisions in Order No's. 369 and 370 remain in full force and effect.
