

O R D E R

On December 30, 1977, the State Engineer, by Order No. 699, designated the Fernley Area Groundwater Basin (5-76), Churchill, Lyon, Storey, and Washoe Counties, Nevada.

On November 21, 1989, the State Engineer, by Order No. 1011, described an area within the Fernley Area Groundwater Basin (5-76) in which municipal, quasi-municipal, and domestic uses were declared preferred uses. That area coincided with the Fernley Town Utilities water and wastewater service area at that time, and can be described as:

T.20N., R.24E. - Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, that portion of Section 10 lying within Lyon County, E $\frac{1}{2}$ , N $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , and SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 15, NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 22, N $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 23, N $\frac{1}{2}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , and NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 24.

T.20N., R.25E. - Sections 3, 7, 8, 9, 18 and 19, that portion of Sections 4 and 5 lying within Lyon County, W $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 27, and W $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 20.

On January 23, 1990, the Fernley Town Board, by Ordinance No. 7, expanded the boundaries of the Fernley Town Utilities water and wastewater service area.

Following a public hearing to consider expanding the preferred use area to coincide with the new Fernley Town Utilities water and wastewater service area, an Order is hereby made by the State Engineer and entered into the records of the Division of Water Resources, expanding the area described in Order No. 1011, to now read:

All land and property within that part of Lyon County, Nevada, lying north of the east/west township line between T.18N., and T.19N., M.D.B.&M.

Therefore, for the above described area, municipal, quasi-municipal, and domestic uses are declared preferred uses.

All other provisions in Order No's. 699 and 1011 remain in full force and effect.
