WHEREAS, the records of the Clark County Assessor's Office indicate that Robert B. Jr. and Joan E. Stuart are the owners of record of Assessor's Parcel Number 650-030-007 which is located within the E½ of the E½ of Section 1, T.13S., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.;

WHEREAS, the records of the Clark County Assessor's Office indicate that Robert B. Jr. and Joan E. Stuart are also the owners of record of Assessor's Parcel Number 660-130-002 which is located within the W½ of the W½ of Section 6, T.13S., R.66E., M.D.B.&M.;

WHEREAS, the records of the Division of Water Resources indicate there is a Temporary Permit No. 61289-T on record for the E½ SE¼, Section 1, T.13S., R.65E., and the W½ SW¼ Section 6, T.13S., R.66E., M.D.B.&M., being Clark County Assessor's Parcel Numbers 650-030-007 and 660-130-002.

WHEREAS, a field investigation was conducted on March 26, 1996, by staff of the Southern Nevada Branch Office of the Nevada Division of Water Resources. Said investigation found that water was being diverted from Meadow Valley Wash Creek by means of a dam and diversion channel on Parcel Number 650-030-007 and being used for a gravel processing plant on Parcel Numbers 650-030-007 and 660-130-002.

WHEREAS, Temporary Permit No. 61289-T was issued on November 28, 1995, for a one year period, for the diversion of 2.0 cubic feet per second not to exceed 145.0 acre-feet annually.

WHEREAS, the waters of Meadow Valley Wash Creek have been continuously diverted since the issuance of Temporary Permit No. 61289-T, from a point other than the legal point of diversion described under Temporary Permit 61289-T. This continuous diversion has caused the total allowed diversion of 145.0 acre-feet from any and all sources to be exceeded and is impairing existing down stream rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, YOU AND ALL OF YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED to cease and desist immediately the use of water from this diversion. It is further ordered that said dam be removed from the waters of Meadow Valley Wash Creek within fourteen (14) days of the date of this Order.
