
IN THE MATTER OF THE DETERMINATION

ORDER GRANTING
PETITION.

W. B. Richards, Jr., Henry W. Richards, Stephen C. Richards, and John D. Richards, claimants to the waters of Colonel Moore Creek and its tributaries in Elko County, Nevada, having duly petitioned the State Engineer on July 15, 1954 requesting the determination of the relative rights of the claimants to the waters thereof, and the State Engineer having decided, after due investigation, that facts and conditions warrant the initiation of proceedings to affect such determination, he therefore, by virtue of the authority granted him in Section 18, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, enters this
