Gentlemen:

Your request for water diverted on behalf of the McKinley Cattle Company, and dated July 27, 1961, has been given careful consideration.

At the present time I have no official knowledge of any land or water rights in the name of McKinley Cattle Company as they have not submitted any deed to this office showing their title. I note that you allege ownership under Proofs Nos. 00213, 00230 and 00382.

So that you will be in a position to take earlier legal action without the delay which would be caused by filing the required deeds and the checking of those deeds, I am herewith issuing an Order which states the position of the State Engineer relative to the rights under the aforementioned proofs.

It is the opinion of the State Engineer that the priorities type of culture and acreages under Proofs Nos. 00213, 00230 and 00382 are those shown tabulated in the Supplemental Order of Determination which was filed at the request of the Court in Case No. 2804 in the Sixth Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada in and for the County of Humboldt.

It is the Order of the State Engineer that the water be distributed according to the tabulation shown in the Supplemental Order of Determination.
