REVOCATION OF WELL DRILLER'S LICENSE)
NO. 453 ISSUED TO MR. A. M. NIGHTINGALE) ORDER
DBA N & G WELL SERVICING CO., P.O. BOX)
5041, RENO, NEVADA)

An Application for a Well Driller's License was received on September 23, 1964, with the statutory filing fee of \$25.00 in the form of a check dated September 21, 1964, drawn on the account of N & G Well Servicing Co. signed by A. M. Nightingale.

Said application was considered by the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board at the December 2, 1964 meeting and recommended approval of the applicant for a well driller's license to the State Engineer. The State Engineer issued Well Driller's License No. 453 to A. M. Nightingale dba N & G Well Servicing Co., P.O. Box 5041, Reno, Nevada.

On January 29, 1965, the State Engineer received notice from the First National Bank, Keystone Avenue Branch, Reno, Nevada, said check dated September 21, 1964, was returned marked "Account Closed."


On February 4, 1965, the State Engineer sent by certified mail a letter to Mr. Nightingale requesting the \$25.00 fee be resubmitted in the form of a certified check or money order. The letter was returned stamped "Unclaimed."

On April 1, 1965, the State Engineer sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, a letter to Mr. Nightingale advising him that a hearing would be held on April 23, 1965, at 11:00 o'clock in the morning in the State Engineer's office in Carson City, Nevada, on the matter of revocation of his well driller's license for failure to provide the statutory filing fee.

At the regular noticed time and place, Mr. A. M. Nightingale failed to appear.

Well Driller's License No. 453, issued to Mr. A. M. Nightingale, dba N & G Well Servicing Company, P. O. Box 5041, Reno, Nevada, is hereby revoked for the reason that said licensee failed to provide the statutory filing fee of \$25.00 as provided by NRS 534.140 and said Mr. Nightingale is hereby ordered to return License No. 453, and is ordered not to engage in water well drilling in the State of Nevada without first obtaining proper license.
