
Dear Mr. Bennett:

Under the provisions of NRS 535.050, the State Engineer has the authority to order the removal of dams or obstructions that have been placed in any stream channel or watercourse when such dams or obstructions have not been legally established.

The water rights on Ash Canyon Creek were determined by Decree on November 14, 1885 in the District Court of the Second Judicial District of the State of Nevada in and for the County of Ormsby.

The channel of Ash Canyon Creek situated on your property is now obstructed by a rock dam approximately 3 feet in height which prevents unrestricted flow of creek waters.

You are hereby ordered and given notice that you are required to immediately proceed to remove all obstructions from this channel, within its course on your property, to provide a capacity for conveying the waters of Ash Canyon Creek.
