It appearing to me, J. G. Scrugham, State Engineer of the State of Nevada, from the petition of Samuel T. Wines and Crystal Land Company, filed in the office of the State Engineer, State of Nevada on the 16th day of October, 1919, that the relative rights to the use of water of the various claimants upon the said Overland Creek and its Tributaries in the County of Elko, State of Nevada, should be determined:

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered, that Overland Creek and its Tributaries, a stream system situated in Elko County, State of Nevada, is hereby selected for the determination of relative rights to the use of water of the various claimants thereon.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the proceedings for the determination of the relative rights to the waters of said Overland Creek and its Tributaries, situate in Elko County, State of Nevada, shall begin on the 21st day of October, 1919. All claimants to rights in the waters of said stream system are required to make proof of their claims in the manner prescribed by law.
