

Certificate 7009 (Permit 14870) was issued for 0.10 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for quasi-municipal (trailer park) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is described as being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7, T.21S., R.62E., M.D.M.

Nevada Revised Statutes provide that failure for five (5) successive years to use beneficially all or any part of the underground water for the purpose for which such right has been acquired shall work a forfeiture to the use of such water to the extent of such nonuse.

Records, evidence and information on file in the Office of the State Engineer indicate that there has been no beneficial use of water under the subject Certificate and Permit for a period in excess of five (5) successive years.

It is hereby ordered that Certificate 7009 (Permit 14870) is declared forfeited in its entirety.
