ORDER

DESIGNATING AND DESCRIBING
THE PLEASANT VALLEY GROUND WATER BASIN
WASHOE COUNTY, NEVADA

The State Engineer finds that conditions warrant the designation of the Pleasant Valley Ground Water Basin, Washoe County, Nevada, and by this Order, designates the following area of land as a ground water basin coming under the provisions of Chapter 534, NRS (Conservation and Distribution of Underground Waters).

T.17N., R.18E., M.D.B. & M.

That portion of Sections 12, 13, 14, 15, 22, 23, 24 and 25 lying within the natural drainage of Pleasant Valley.

T.17N., R.19E., M.D.B. & M.

All of Sections 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 16, 17, 18, and that portion of Sections 1, 5, 6, 7, 13, 14, 15, 19, 20, 21, 22, 24 and 30 lying within the natural drainage of Pleasant Valley.

T.17N., R.20E., M.D.B. & M.


All of Sections 4, 7, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16, 17, 18, and that portion of Sections 2, 3, 5, 6, 11, 14, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 27, 28 and 29 lying within the natural drainage of Pleasant Valley.

T.18N., R.19E., M.D.B. & M.

That portion of Sections 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 lying within the natural drainage of Pleasant Valley.

T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B. & M.

That portion of Sections 32, 33 and 34 lying within the natural drainage of Pleasant Valley.
