ORDER

NOTICE OF CURTAILMENT OF WATER APPROPRIATION
WITHIN THE SALMON FALLS CREEK AREA BASIN

The State Engineer designated the Salmon Falls Creek Area Basin as provided under NRS 534.010 to 534.190, inclusive, by Order 736 dated February 15, 1980.

The irrigation of additional land using underground water would threaten to impair the value of existing underground and surface water rights now being used for municipal, quasi-municipal, domestic, irrigation, recreation, mining, milling, commercial and stock watering purposes.

In accordance with NRS 534.120, subsection 2, the irrigation of additional land using underground water is not considered to be a preferred use of the limited underground water resource.

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordered that:

All applications filed after February 15, 1980 to appropriate underground water to irrigate additional land within the Salmon Falls Creek Area Ground Water Basin will be denied.
