ORDER

NOTICE OF CURTAILMENT OF WATER APPROPRIATION
WITHIN THE KINGS RIVER VALLEY BASIN #30

The State Engineer designated the Kings River Valley Basin as provided under NRS 534.010 to 534.190, inclusive by Order 740 dated April 2, 1980.

The irrigation of additional land using underground water would threaten to impair the value of existing underground and surface water rights now being used for quasi-municipal, domestic, irrigation, recreation, mining, milling, commercial, and stock watering purposes.

In accordance with NRS 534.120, subsection 2, the irrigation of additional land using underground water is not considered to be a preferred use of the limited underground water resources.

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordered that:

All applications filed after April 24, 1980, to appropriate underground water to irrigate additional land within the Kings River Valley Ground Water Basin will be denied.
