On October 9, 1985, Ross deLipkau, Counsel for the Cecil Martin Family and Rose Creek Ranch, claimant to the use of water of Rose Creek and Tributaries, in Humboldt and Pershing Counties, Nevada, petitioned the State Engineer to determine the relative rights of claimants to the waters of said source.

After due investigation, the State Engineer decided that facts and conditions warrant the initiation of proceedings to effect such determination.

By virtue of the authority granted him in NRS 533.090, the state Engineer enters this;

Order granting the petition of the above-named claimant and will make proper arrangements to proceed with the determination in question.
