This office has determined by field investigation and dam inspection that the El Dorado Dam located in Section 31, T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., Lyon County, Nevada, has become an unsafe structure due to failure of the spillway. The condition of the dam has been determined to be a threat to public safety and private property and, therefore, under the authority set forth under NRS 535.030, you are hereby

ORDERED to:

1. Maintain the outlet control structure fully open until further notice;
2. Empty the reservoir and evacuate all storage water in the reservoir through release at the outlet structure;
3. Within 90 days of this date, submit to the State Engineer a preliminary plan to either rebuild the spillway or to remove the dam;
4. Within 180 days of this date, submit to the State Engineer, detailed plans and specifications prepared by a registered Civil Engineer to repair the spillway or remove the dam.

No storage shall be allowed in the El Dorado Dam, under any circumstances, until further notice.
