

WHEREAS, the State Engineer has granted Permits 48650, 48651, 48652, 48653, 48654, 48655 and 48656, pursuant to NRS 533 and 534, under the name of Valley Water Company for a total combined duty of water from underground sources not to exceed 364.06 million gallons annually (1117.26 acre-feet).

A letter dated April 1, 1987, from the office of the State Engineer to Valley Water Company confirmed that pumpage records for 1984, 1985 and 1986 exceeded the annual duty under said permits by 6 to 10 percent. That letter also served notice to reduce the pumpage to the duty allowed under the permits.

Pumpage records for 1987 indicate the amount of water pumped under the subject permits was 441.24 million gallons (1353.96 acre-feet) or 21.2 percent over and above the amount permitted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that you cease and desist any pumpage of water under the above described permits in excess of the amount authorized by those permits.
