By field investigation conducted on April 6 and April 13, 1988, we have determined that an illegal diversion of Home Ranch Canyon Creek has caused the stream to flow outside its natural channel to your property located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5, T.21N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., where it is impounded in two separate structures before any of the stream flow is allowed to continue down the canyon.

You were advised by Division of Water Resources representatives that there is no record of a lawful appropriation of water or claim of vested right for your parcel in the office of the State Engineer.

Nevada Revised Statutes chapter 533.460 provides "The unauthorized use of water to which another person is entitled, or the willful waste of water to the detriment of another, shall be a misdemeanor, and the possession or use of such water without legal right shall be prima facie evidence of the guilt of the person using or diverting it."

THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED to cease diversion of Home Ranch Canyon Creek and to restore the flow to the natural stream channel forthwith.
