The records of the Clark County Assessor's office disclose that you own property located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17, T.21S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., Parcel No. 140-150-018. The State Engineer's office has determined that a water well is located on the property and is presently being utilized by Cind-R-Lite Company.

The records of the Division of Water Resources show that Cind-R-Lite Company has caused an additional well to be commenced within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17, T.21S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., Parcel No. 140-150-018.

The locations of these wells are within the boundaries of the Las Vegas Artesian Basin designated and described under Order No. 833 dated December 27, 1983. NRS 534.050, subsection 1, states:

"Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, every person desiring to sink or bore a well in any basin or portion therein in the state designated by the state engineer, as provided for in this chapter shall first make application to obtain from the state engineer a permit to appropriate the water, in accordance with the provisions of chapter 533 of NRS relating to the appropriation of the public waters, before performing any work in connection with the boring or sinking of the well."

NRS 534.050, subsection 5, states:

"Any person using water after a permit has been withdrawn, denied, canceled, revoked or forfeited is guilty of a misdemeanor. Each day of violation of this subsection constitutes a separate offense and is separately punishable."

THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED to cease any and all diversion within thirty (30) days of the date of this order.

The records of the State Engineer's office reflect no permit or existing water right for wells at this location. The State Engineer's records also indicate that water service is available from the Las Vegas Valley Water District to this property.

Upon written proof from the Las Vegas Valley Water District that application for service has been made within this thirty (30) day time period, a thirty (30) day extension will be granted to allow for the installation of service from the Las Vegas Valley Water District.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the partially completed well be immediately plugged in accordance with Part 14 of the Well Drilling Regulations and that the existing well be plugged within sixty (60) days of the date of this order.
