

WHEREAS, this office has determined through field investigation on April 27, 1989, that you are the owner of a domestic water well drilled at 28 Sierra View Road on Washoe County Parcel No. 81-140-26. The subject well was constructed by Wayne Drilling, Inc., on October 31, 1988, to a depth of 175 feet under Washoe County Health Department Permit No. 3393, and is presently serving water to a single family dwelling on the subject parcel.

WHEREAS, this office has received a copy of an agreement dated October 7, 1988 by and between Reno Park Water Company (Reno Park) and Herbert Goss wherein water service was to be provided by Reno Park to the subject parcel. This office further has documents pertaining to the incorporation of the subject parcel into the certificated service area of Reno Park as regulated by the Nevada Public Service Commission, as well as the "will serve" commitment by the Reno Park dated August 9, 1988.

WHEREAS, NRS 534.120(3)(d) authorizes the State Engineer to prohibit the drilling of domestic wells in areas where water can be furnished by an entity such as a water district presently engaged in furnishing water to the inhabitants thereof. The records of the State Engineer's office disclose no evidence that any specific authorization was granted by the State Engineer for the drilling of the subject well.

THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to the authority under NRS 534.120(1) and 534.120(3)(d), to immediately cease and desist any use of this well and are further ordered to plug and seal the subject well immediately as set forth under Regulations for Drilling Water Wells, Part 14.
