R U L I N G

General:


Application No. 10986 was filed on August 20, 1943 by Lawrence G. McNeil for permission to appropriate 0.40 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4, T. 21S., R. 61E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within the S $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4, T. 21S., R. 61E., M.D.B.&M.

A permit was issued on December 6, 1943 under Application No. 10986 for 0.40 c.f.s. of water for quasi-municipal and domestic use. The Proof of Commencement of Work was filed on February 17, 1944 and the Proof of Completion of Work was filed on June 28, 1946. The Proof of Beneficial Use was filed on April 7, 1955. Application and Permit No. 10986 was assigned to Victor V. Kunkel by deed dated April 14, 1947 and filed in this office on June 24, 1948. The first notice for issuing and recording the certificate was forwarded on January 23, 1968 to Mr. Victor V. Kunkel. Final notice was sent to Mr. Victor V. Kunkel by certified mail on March 5, 1968 and a return receipt card was received in this office on March 11, 1968 properly signed by Victor V. Kunkel. In a letter dated March 4, 1968, Mr. Kunkel stated that the well under Permit No. 10986 had not been used for several years and that he had sold the property.

RULING

Permit No. 10986 is herewith cancelled on the grounds that the permittee has failed to submit the statutory fee for issuing and recording of the certificate of appropriation as provided by NRS 533.425 after proper notice.
