General:

Application 21708 was filed December 26, 1963 to appropriate 5.4 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 19, T. 18 N., S. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., and the place of use is 160 acres of land located within the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 19, T. 18 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M.

This office was notified by the Bureau of Land Management, by letter dated May 21, 1968, that the proposed place of use under this application was vacant public land and that there were no land entries pending on this land.

Opinion:

It is the opinion of this office that the granting of an application where the applicant does not own or control the land on which he plans to place the water to beneficial use would be detrimental to the public welfare and not in the best public interest.

RULING

Application 21708 is herewith denied on the grounds that the granting of this application would be detrimental to the public welfare and not in the best public interest.


RULING
