GENERAL:

Application 21500 was filed on September 4, 1963, to appropriate 6 cfs of water from and underground source for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20, T19N., R55E., MDB&M., and the place of use is located within the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, T19N., R55E., MDB&M.

The application was filed in support of Desert Land Entry Nevada 059915 on 320 acres. This office was informed by the Bureau of Land Management that Desert Land Entry Nevada 059915 had been cancelled in its entirety on November 16, 1964.

OPINION:

It is the opinion of this office that the granting of an application where the applicant does not own or control the land on which he plans to place the water to beneficial use would be detrimental to the public welfare and the orderly development of the area.

RULING:

Application 21500 is herewith denied on the grounds that its granting would be detrimental to the public welfare.
