R U L I N G

GENERAL

Application 3823 was filed March 4, 1916, by W. B. Griffeth to appropriate 1.2 c.f.s. of water from Dry Gulch for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as within Lot 4, Section 18, T.40N., R.53E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as 120 acres located within N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 13, T.40N., R.52E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter dated July 24, 1968, was sent by certified mail to the best available address for the applicant requesting additional information necessary before a Permit could be issued under this Application. This letter was returned, stamped: "Unclaimed", by the Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 3823 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the requested information and the granting of this Application without said information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
