

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION 29 FILED
BY THOS HILL, T. R. OFER, AND F. L.
WILDES, TO APPROPRIATE WATER FROM THE
TRUCKEE RIVER IN WASHOE COUNTY, NEVADA.)

R U L I N G

General:

Application 29 was filed December 26, 1905 by Thos Hill, T. R. Ofer and F. L. Wildes; for 500 c.f.s. of water from the Truckee River for electrical purposes. The proposed point of diversion was described as within the southern part of T. 20N., R. 22E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use was not described. The water was to be returned to the stream "at a point where power is generated". The water was to be used for the production of 6,000 horsepower.

A letter was sent by this office by certified mail to the applicants on July 26, 1968, requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. This letter was returned by the Post office Department stamped "insufficient address". It is the responsibility of the applicants or their successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application No. 29 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and that the approval of this application, without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
