General:


Application No. 79 was filed April 7, 1906 by J. P. Fitting and J. G. Musser for all the flow of water from the largest creek in Jefferson Canyon for mining, milling, power, and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion and proposed place of use were not described on the application.

A letter was sent by this office by certified mail on July 26, 1968 requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department stamped "insufficient address". It is the responsibility of the applicants or their successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current address.

RULING

Application No. 79 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and that the approval of this application without this information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
