R U L I N G

GENERAL

Application 81 was filed April 13, 1906, by A. B. Bigler to appropriate all the flow of Three Springs for mining and milling purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the S $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 12, T.6S., R.40E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use was not described in the Application.

A letter dated July 26, 1968, was sent by certified mail to the best available address for the applicant requesting additional information necessary before a Permit could be issued under this Application. This letter was returned, stamped: "Unclaimed", by the Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.
