General:


Application No. 84 was filed on April 17, 1906 by E. D. Morton to appropriate 12.0 c.f.s. of water from Kalamazoo Creek for power purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as being within Section 30, T. 20N., R. 66E., M.D.B.&M., and the proposed place of use is located in Section 28, T. 20N., R. 66E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent by this office by certified mail on July 26, 1968 requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department, stamped "address unknown, no such office in State". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successor in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application No. 82 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and that the approval of this application, without this information, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
