General:

Application No. 107 was filed on May 31, 1906 by Irving Peterson to appropriate all of the flow of a spring "known as South Manhattan Spring" for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as about five miles in a southerly direction from Manhattan, Nevada. The proposed place of use is near the spring.

A letter dated July 26, 1968 was sent by certified mail to the best available address for the applicant requesting additional information necessary before a permit can be issued under this application. This letter was returned, stamped "unknown", by the Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application No. 107 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit requested information and the approval of this application without said information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
