RULING

GENERAL:


Application 517 was filed June 10, 1906, by G. H. Phillips, R. Tidwell, F. H. Sanford and C. L. Clark for permission to appropriate 10.0 cfs of water from an underground source for mining and milling purposes. The points of diversion are wells to be sunk along the course of Monumental Canyon with no legal subdivision or ties given. The proposed place of use is within Gold Bud, Rose Bud and Rose Bud Mining District.

A letter dated July 24, 1968, was sent by certified mail by this office to the best available address for the applicants. Said letter requested additional information regarding the proposed points of diversion and if the applicants were still interested in pursuing this application. The letter was returned stamped "No such post office in state named", by the Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successor in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING:

Application 517 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest have failed to submit requested additional information, and that the granting of this application without the requested information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
