RULING

GENERAL:


Application 86 was filed on April 19, 1906, by W. S. Kellett, and D. H. Robbe to appropriate water from Indian Garden Spring for mining, and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion was not described on the application. The proposed place of use is described as within Section 1, T2S., R50E.

A letter, dated July 26, 1968, was sent to the applicant at the best available address, requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. The letter was returned stamped "No such post office in said state" by the Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicants or their successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 86 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest failed to submit the requested information necessary before a permit can be issued under this application, and that the granting of a permit under this application without the requested information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
