GENERAL:


Application 6208 was filed July 24, 1920 by T. L. Chaney for one c.f.s. of water for irrigation and domestic purposes. The source of the proposed appropriation is Dutch Creek and Indian Creek. The places of diversion are described as being from Indian Creek Gulch at a point in its SW corner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 20, and from Dutch Creek at a point in the West portion of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 20, T. 9 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B.&M. The 100 acres described under the place of use are within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 20 and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 21, all in T. 9 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent by this office by certified mail to the applicant on August 12, 1968, requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Postal Department stamped "unclaimed." It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 6208 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information required and the approval of this application, without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
