R U L I N G

Application 5984 was filed February 11, 1920, by Union Land and Cattle Co. for 1.20 c.f.s. of water for irrigation purposes. The proposed source is an unnamed spring described as being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 15, T.37N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M. The 120 acres described under the place of use are within the E $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 14, T.37N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent by this office by certified mail to the applicant on August 9, 1968, requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this Application. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department stamped: "Addressee Unknown." It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of a current mailing address.

RULING

Application 5984 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this Application, without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
