R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Applications No. 21133 and 21134 were filed on March 18, 1963 by Mary V. Wilburn, Marion H. Wilburn, and Marjorie Grubb for permission to appropriate .2 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for quasi-municipal (trailer court, apartments, and swimming pool) purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T. 16S., R. 49E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is the same subdivision as the point of diversion.


A letter dated April 6, 1966 was sent requesting additional information before action could be taken on this application.

A letter, dated May 16, 1968, was sent by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned to this office on May 31, 1968 with a note added to the bottom stating "sold property in 1962".

RULING

Applications 21133 and 21134 are herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest failed to submit the requested information and the approval of this application without said information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
